Maths in Reception

This week in Reception, we have been focusing on subitising. Subitising is the ability to look at a small set of objects and instantly know how many there are without counting them. The children enjoyed playing subitise Bingo!

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We have been using these skills to see sub groups within larger sets - for example that four can be arranged with 2 blocks on top of another 2 blocks or as a line of 3 with 1 on top
